NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussion of application process, time lines and procedures for hiring a full-time police officer for Dallas Borough.
 - Applications being accepted for hiring test(s) advertised though Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police website, local newspaper, Borough website and FaceBook with applications due **by 2:00 pm on Friday, April 17, 2026.**
 - Post notice in borough office.
 - Record all applications received.
 - Provide each applicant with a notice of the time/place for the 1st portion of testing (written exam).
 - Procter written exam (60% of exam score) to be done at the **Dallas Borough Municipal Building, 25 Main Street, Dallas PA 18612 on Monday, April 27, 2026 at 10:00 am.**
 - Applicant sent their test results within 30 days.
 - Applicant moves on if passes each section and has an overall score of at least 70% AND is a top 30 candidate.

- Physical agility test (pass or fail) to be conducted at the **Back Mountain Recreation Inc. Fields, 55 Outlet Road, Dallas PA 18612 on Monday, May 11, 2026 at 9:00 am with a proctor to be determined by the Police Chief.**
 - Commission approves testing to be done upon recommendation of Police Chief.
 - DB rules dictate we use most up to date MPOETC Physical Skills Evaluation Protocols in effect at the time test is administered.
- Oral Exam (40% of exam score) to be scheduled the **week of May 11, 2026** with a committee to be determined by the Police Chief at a later date.
 - Applicant sent their test results within 30 days of oral and overall scores, if passing then advised of next steps.
 - Applicant questioned on how he/she would handle situations relevant to police work.
 - Oral exam graded on 100 point scale with a score of 70% or higher necessary to pass.
- Veteran /Soldier status
 - If applicant passed the written and oral exams, a qualified veteran/ soldier shall receive 10 points on top of the combined, weighted written and oral exams.
- Polygraph (optional)
- Creation of Eligibility List (or supplementing the current Eligibility List)
 - Commission ranks all passing applicants on a list with highest score at the top.
 - Veteran/Soldiers points are added to his/her ‘passing’ score prior to being ranked on the eligibility list.
 - List is valid for 2 years.
- Background exam
 - Any applicant who appears on the eligibility list and successfully passes the polygraph (optional) shall then be required to pass a background exam.
 - Can be done once Council certifies a candidate(s) for appointment.
 - Police Chief can do the background investigation at the request of the Commission.
- Applicant(s) chosen by Council for appointment.
 - Applicant is offered “conditional” employment.
 - Final appointment after passing medical and psychological exams.
