3. BOROUGH CONSULTING ENGINEER: Report and project update:
 - DEP MS4 compliance.
 - Notice of Violation from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) on February 24, 2026 regarding MS4 – Failure to Implement Approved Pollution Reduction Plan in required time frame: Manager Carr, Mr. Berger and Mr. McCarthy attended the enforcement conference on Wednesday, June 10th at the DEP office in Wilkes-Barre. Discussion included a breakdown of the remaining projects to complete the Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP), times frames for completion and Clean Stream Law liabilities and penalties.
