1st QTR — Due January 31, 2020

2nd QTR — Due April 30, 2020

Hardship applications are due April 30, 2020

3rd QTR — Due July 31, 2020

4th QTR — Due October 31, 2020

Yearly Payments are Due by January 31, 2020, to receive a 2% discount.

Payments by cash or check are accepted at First National Community Bank (FNCB) located in Shavertown, or at the DAMA Administration Office.

COMPOSTING FOR RESIDENTS



Rules for composting:

- For residents only of Dallas and Kingston Township and Dallas Borough and Lehman Township.
- **No contractors and/or commercial landscapers**, no construction debris, no plastics, no metal, no lawn furniture, no rocks or stone, no stumps, no painted, stained or pressure treated wood.
- Only clean leaf and yard waste, remember this material will be applied to resident's homes and gardens.
- The composting program operates on funds from the trash bill, your continued support greatly keeps the cost down, material clean, and the program operating correctly.

Compost Program Update:

DAMA's consolidated, PA DEP permitted composting site is open for residents. The site is located on route 118, 1.75 miles from the intersection of route 118 and route 415. Residents will still be able to drop-off leaf and yard waste at their municipalities and pick up compost. All processing and composting of material will be completed at the route 118 site.
